COMMUNION FOR HOMEBOUND:

No ministers are allowed to bring communion to the homebound at this time.

MESSAGE TO ALL PASTORS OF THE ARCHDIOCESE OF CHICAGO

Dear Fathers,

Thanks to your collective efforts, the reopening of our churches this summer has been, by all current measures, a success. And, in large part, adherence to our protocols and guidelines has protected our churches from becoming sources of COVID-19 exposure.

With this in mind, we are at a critical juncture. Any time a modicum of success is achieved, there is a temptation to assume it will sustain itself without the same effort that was required to achieve it. We know better. We must remain just as vigilant now as we were in May preparing for the reopening of our churches. Consider the following:

- An increasing number of counties in Illinois are on the Illinois Department of Public Health watch list
- Key indicators, such as the COVID-19 infection positivity rate and 7-day trend, are moving in the wrong direction
- We are about to enter the annual flu season

At no time do we want to move backward and find ourselves with closed church doors. And with only a few months until the start of Advent, such an occurrence would be disheartening for us. On behalf of the people of God, I implore you to sustain your efforts and follow the published guidelines and protocols to the letter, and to refrain from creating any exceptions that violate the fundamental safeguards of wearing masks, maintaining physical distance, etc.

Please continue communicating with your parishioners the importance of exhibiting positive behaviors both in school and outside parish life. Please share this graphic noting everyone's responsibility.

VOLUNTEERS NEEDED

The number of Masses and other services we can offer and the number of people allowed in church will be directly tied to how many volunteers will be available to set-up, greet/usher and clean-up before and after each service. *To volunteer or receive more information about volunteering, email:*

stovreopen@stov.org

Set-up team: Volunteers will ensure that: all supplies needed for each sacramental celebration/gathering are ready for use, entrances and exits are marked and propped physically open prior to attendees' arrival/departure, windows are opened, restrooms are stocked and managed. They will ensure hand sanitizer is available and that pews are marked off according to social distancing guidelines. **18 years or older.**

Greeting team: Greeters will assist in managing the flow of congregants as they enter the church, participate in the liturgy/sacrament, and exit the church. Team members will combine some of the functions of an usher, such as directing participants to appropriate seating/waiting areas, but will include additional responsibilities, including, making sure attendees use hand sanitizer upon entering, are wearing a mask, and are reminded not to enter if ill. Given the circumstances, greeters will need to be tactful and firm paying careful attention to all people on-site. **Must be 18 -65 years old.**

Cleaning team: These volunteers will help maintain and clean essential and trafficked areas of the church before and after the church has been used. Masks and gloves will be provided, if necessary, in addition to approved cleaning/disinfecting supplies. Parishes need to develop appropriate schedules and verification methods to ensure cleaning occurs at the proper times relative to when congregants arrive and leave the building. **18 years or older. Note: High schoolers allowed with permission of parents.**

WEEKEND MASSES

All who wish to attend Weekend Mass will be required to sign-up.
NO WALK-INS, PLEASE!

Signup to attend weekend Mass will open on Thursday mornings at 9:00am. Look for a Flocknote with the link to signup for Mass or signup on our website: www.stov.org—under the Reopening tab.

- Each individual person wishing to attend Mass must be registered.
- If you (or if you know someone) are not able to register online due to a lack of computer / internet access, please call the parish by 5pm on Friday at 847-358-6999 . Someone will get back to you and help you register, if spots are available.
- Pre-Mass registration is needed for contact tracing if someone gets sick. Attendance records will be destroyed every 14 days.
- Seats will be sanitized before each Mass.
- Masks must be worn and social distancing will be observed at all times in the Church and building.

***NOTE:** While we are excited to resume public Mass, the Archdiocesan dispensation for Spiritual Communion remains. There is no Sunday Mass attendance requirement at this time. If you feel sick, State and Archdiocese guidelines ask that you remain at home. If you feel uncomfortable or unsafe, please do not feel an obligation to join us physically in the church. If you are considered part of the 'vulnerable population', we welcome you to join us IF you are comfortable to do so. We desire to be reunited with you, but we understand the seriousness of COVID-19.*

WEEKDAY MASS

Every Tuesday & Thursday - 8:00am

Come celebrate Mass and receive the Eucharist with us! No pre-registration is required for weekday Mass. However, you will need to sign in upon arrival. PLEASE arrive early to allow enough time. Doors will open at 7:40am. The doors will be closed once Mass begins, so please don't be late.

ADORATION

Join us each Wednesday from 6pm - 7pm in church for silent prayer before the Holy Eucharist. Just like daily Mass, no pre-registration will be required. However, you will need to sign-in when you arrive. You are invited to come pray for the entire hour or just a little while - whatever fits your schedule.

OTHER SERVICES

Reconciliation is available by appointment only. Leave a voicemail message at the Parish Office - 847-358-6999 and one of the priests will return your call. We continue to celebrate Baptisms, wedding and funeral Masses.

MASS INTENTIONS

If you would like to have a Mass celebrated in honor or memory of someone, please either call 847-358-6999 or email STOVReopen@stov.org. Donations can be mailed to our Parish (1201 E. Anderson Dr, Palatine, IL 60074) or dropped in the offertory box, if you attend Mass. If you are requesting a particular date, please contact us at least 2 weeks prior to the date of the intention. Adhering to these practices has been extremely helpful thus far. We have worked so hard to make our Church a safe place to pray in the midst of this pandemic.

Remember, too, that the Archdiocesan dispensation for Spiritual Communion remains. There is no Sunday Mass attendance requirement at this time.

Together, let us pray for a swift end to the coronavirus pandemic that afflicts our world, that our God and Father will heal the sick, strengthen those who care for them, and help us all to persevere in faith. Amen.





XXIII NIEDZIELA ZWYKŁA – Pozyskać brata

Upomnienie braterskie to wielka sztuka życia. Możemy upominać z agresją, bo coś się nam nie podoba, drażni nas, czegoś w drugim nie akceptujemy. Wtedy jednak łatwo kogoś poniżyć, oskarżyć, skrzywdzić. Nigdy nie mamy wglądu w serce i intencje drugiego człowieka. Dlatego tak ważne jest, by przed spotkaniem z bliźnim spotkać na modlitwie Jezusa i zapytać Go o światło i rozwiązanie, a potem wsłuchać się we własne serce i zapytać siebie, jakiego dobra pragnę dla tej osoby. Upomnienie płynące z miłości, ze szczerej troski o dobro drugiego otwiera serce i umożliwia przemianę. Jest zaproszeniem do rozwoju.

O co chodzi w adoracji?**

‘Zdarza wam się nie mieć czasu na adorację? Albo nie móc wysiedzieć godziny czy nawet kwadransa, który sobie zaplanowaliście? Albo zasypiać w trakcie? Mnie się niestety zdarza. Choćby dlatego, że adoracja po prostu jest trudna. Obecność Jezusa w Eucharystii jest naprawdę wąską bramą, przez którą trzeba się przeciskać’ mówi abp Ryś.

Nasze zmysły ‘świrują’ albo zasypiają, bo nie ma tu dla nich nic atrakcyjnego. Nic do oglądania – kawałek hostii w monstrancji. Nic do słuchania – cisza. Jest i drugi powód. My sami. Ja. Zaganiany, zmęczony, rozbity, w pół drogi między jednym a drugim zadaniem, między trzecią i czwartą sprawą. No i kolejna adoracja zmar-

nowana, mniej lub bardziej dostownie przespana. Często na własne życzenie. A jednak nie do końca.

Bo On jest jak gość, który czeka na ciebie w twoim mieszkaniu. Z takich czy innych powodów znowu masz dla Niego mniej czasu, niż planowałaś. A jednak czeka. Tym bardziej zadbaj, by tej resztki czasu nie zmarnować, by po prostu być. On po prostu jest. Ty też masz po prostu być. Nawet jeśli rozmowa się nie klei. Z przyjacielem nie zawsze trzeba o czymś gadać. Po tym poznajemy, że ktoś jest dla nas bliski, że potrafimy z nim milczeć. Nie trzeba mieć przygotowanego programu na każdą minutę, jak na wizytę oficjalnego gościa, jak na akademię ku czci. Ostatecznie można się przy nim nawet zdrzemnąć na chwilę i on to zrozumie.

On jest jak gość w twoim mieszkaniu, o którego obecności myślisz w ciągu dnia. Wiesz, że tam jest, że czeka. Może niecierpliw się, tęskni, wygląda twojego przyjścia. Zobacz Jezusa, który uwięziony w tabernakulum na własne życzenie, wygląda twojego pojawienia się, następuje twoich kroków, zgrzytu klucza w drzwiach. Myślenie o tym Jego czekaniu na ciebie, ta kołująca się gdzieś z tyłu głowy świadomość Jego obecności gdzieś tam w kościele, już jest formą adoracji, a przynajmniej przygotowania do niej. Wracaj do tego na chwilę co jakiś czas. W praktyce modlitwy nazywa się to aktami strzelistymi. To jak taki szybki sygnał:

Wiem, że jesteś. Wiem, że czekasz. Ja też czekam na spotkanie z Tobą. To już prawie tak, jakbyś był obok. Już prawie. Przecież my całe życie jesteśmy już prawie obok Niego. Już zaraz.

Myślenie o Nim w natłoku codziennych obowiązków i zawirowań pomaga właściwie je oceniać. Co to znaczy, że nie wszystko układa się po twojej myśli, jeśli w perspektywie masz spotkanie z Miłością twojego życia? Skoro sam tęsknisz za spotkaniem z Przebaczającym, jak mógłbyś iść na nie samemu po drodze nie przebacząc? Jak przejmować się codziennymi klęskami i niepowodzeniami, skoro tam czeka na ciebie samo Zwycięstwo?

Adoracja to stan umysłu i serca. To nie tylko ta godzina czy kwadrans przed Najświętszym Sakramentem. To stan umysłu, który pamięta i serca, które tęskni. A w ten sposób wyznacza właściwy rytm wszystkim niespokojnym godzinom, jakie dzielą cię od tego Spotkania. Dzielą? Raczej przybliżają.

Co nie znaczy, że samo spotkanie nie wymaga od ciebie zaangażowania i odrobiny wysiłku. Przed wejściem przeczesz myśli i spróbuj powitać Go uśmiechem, nie ziewaniem. 


